DATE: March 10 & 11, 2006
SITE: Corona Centennial High School: 1820 Rimpau Ave, Corona, CA
RULES: Modified National Federation High School Rules (No riding time, minimum rest between matches, and maximum number of matches not in effect). Hair code & fingernails will be enforced by referees.
ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be received by March 4th, 2006. Must make weight entered. No changes at weigh-in. Online register or mail or deliver payable to: **SS TOC** 1817 W Harle Ave, Anaheim CA 92804. Entries that are postmarked on or before deadline but not received by committee will not be accepted. Online registration or Overnight or Traceable mail strongly recommended. Include SASE for confirmation, if mailed.
FEE: Pre-entry of \$25.00. Online registration or Cashier's Check/Money Order Only, if mailed, to be paid by 8:00 pm March 4th, 2006. Wrestler may enter only one weight class and only one division. No changes after entry deadline. Official Entry forms must be used for entry. Please pay and enter as a team when possible.
FORMAT: Collegiate style. Double elimination- NO Challenge for 2nd format. Referee decisions final. All protests to be directed to tournament directors. All age/grade protests must be made before final match of first day of wrestling for that particular age group. **Birth certificates & REPORT CARDS** must be made available if requested by tournament directors.

WEIGHTS

(6th, 7th, & 8th grades are combined)

70, 76, 83, 89, 95, 100, 103, 108, 112, 116, 122, 128, 135, 142, 153, 168, 185, 205, 235

Child abuse, abusive language, disorderly conduct, etc will not be tolerated and will be dealt with severely

TIME PERIODS: 1 ½- 1 ½- 1 ½ Including finals. Consolations 1-1-1. Overtime- One minute then 30 seconds tie breaker if needed.

AWARDS: Trophy for first. Medals for 2nd thru 6th. Ribbons for 7th & 8th. Outstanding wrestler awards based on a champion with most falls in least amount of time (including technical falls) in lower, middle, and higher weight divisions. Team Trophy for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd. All Star Teams cannot compete for team awards.
